Important dates (all programs, campuses, admission types)

August 1, 2023	Fall 2024 applications open	
January 2024	Regional campus admission decisions may be received by applicants with UConn Avery Point, UConn Hartford, UConn Stamford, or UConn Waterbury as their first choice (but an earlier decision is not guaranteed)	
March 1, 2024	Admission decision notification begins. Transfer and regional campus applications submitted after this date – students will be notified of their admission decision approximately 4 to 6 weeks after the application is complete	
June 1, 2024	Deposit deadline – admitted students must pay their enrollment deposit to secure their place at UConn. Students with offers issued close to or after this date have 2 weeks to pay their deposit	
August 1, 2024	I-20 request deadline	
August 26, 2024	Fall classes start

November 15	Storrs	Special Programs (Medicine, Dental Medicine, Law)
December 1	All campuses	Priority application deadline for scholarship consideration

2024		
January 15	Storrs	Official application deadline – higher chance of admission and getting application completed in time
January 15	Storrs	Most degrees in School of Fine Arts* (except Music and Puppetry)
January 31	Storrs	Kaplan deadline extension — UConn will still accept Kaplan applications up to this date, but likelihood of admission and scholarships has reduced by this point. All supporting materials must be fully submitted to UConn (i.e. application status must be complete in the portal)
March 15	UConn Stamford	If university housing is required
May 1	Regional campuses	UConn Stamford – if university housing is not required; UConn Avery Point, UConn Hartford, UConn Waterbury

February 15	UConn Hartford	Social Work major
March 15	UConn Stamford	If university housing is required
April 1	Storrs	Most majors: Allied Health Sciences, Agriculture & Natural Resources, Animal Science, Applied Resource Economics, Environmental Sciences, Environmental Studies, Landscape Architecture, Natural Resources, Nutritional Sciences, Pathobiology, Sustainable Plant & Soil Systems, School of Business, School of Engineering, Art History, Theatre Studies, College of Liberal Arts & Sciences, Pharmacy Studies
May 1	Regional campuses	UConn Stamford – if university housing is not required; UConn Avery Point, UConn Hartford, UConn Waterbury

Housing application deadlines

2024		
May 1	UStorrs	Priority consideration for a place in one of UConn's 34 Learning Communities.
May 24	UConn Stamford	Priority on-campus housing application deadline—early completion is recommended as space is limited. Students admitted after April 1 who are interested in university housing will be considered on a space-available basis.
June 14	Storrs	General on-campus housing application*** —housing assignments will be confirmed in early August.

^{* * *} First-year students at Storrs are required to submit a housing application.

Note: please allow several business days for document processing. All documents must be received by the application deadline to be considered on time. Late applications and applications not completed by the deadline will be reviewed on a space-available basis.
