4 things you need to do now to complete and track your ASU application

<p>1. Send official test score reports</p>	<p>2. Get transcripts sent to ASU if you previously studied in the USA</p>	<p>3. Activate your ASURITE ID</p>	<p>4. Check status of your documents on MyASU</p>
<p>If you are applying with IELTS / TOEFL / DET (Duolingo) / PTE / Cambridge English / SAT / ACT certificates, you must submit your official test score reports electronically, via the testing agencies, to Arizona State University</p>	<p>Ask any US schools, US colleges or US universities you have attended to submit 3 years of official transcripts to ASU directly. Records must include completed courses, grades or marks earned, and certificates or degrees awarded. Do not send transcripts from outside the USA.</p>	<p>In the next 2–3 working days, a message should arrive to the email address that you provided in your ASU application, with the subject "ASU Account Activation". Check your spam folder. You will find helpful setup instructions here: ASURITE ID Setup guide.</p>	<p>Please allow 7–10 business days after submission or score reporting, for the status of your application-related documents to update in MyASU.</p>
<p>Top tip ASU Institution codes are: 4007 for TOEFL / SAT scores; 0088 for ACT scores; no code required for IELTS, PTE and Duolingo.</p>	<p>Top tip US institutions can send transcripts by post, email or through a secured transcript service approved by ASU – see details at admission.asu.edu/apply/transcripts</p>	<p>Top tip If you have trouble logging in with your ASURITE User ID, contact the ASU Help Desk at +1 855-278-5080 or contact.asu.edu</p>	<p>Top tip If test scores still show as incomplete 7 business days after reporting them, please send us screenshots, showing the date of reporting to ASU.</p>
