How to apply

Complete the application form at admission.asu.edu/kaplan/asu-apply and submit the following supporting documents:

- Passport copy
- Proof of English proficiency (IELTS / IELTS Indicator / TOEFL / Duolingo DET / Pearson PTE / Online or Kaplan iBT)
- Official transcripts for the last 3 years at secondary school or post-secondary institutions
- SAT or ACT score: reported officially to ASU (if applicable, depends on a degree, bachelor's applicants only)
- Portfolio (only required for limited programs)

Additional requirements for master's applicants:

(if applicable, depends on a degree)

- GRE or GMAT score: reported officially to ASU
- Official transcripts for every college and university where you earned a bachelor's degree or higher
- CV/résumé
- Personal statement / statement of purpose / essay
- Letters of recommendation: sent directly to ASU by your recommenders

After admission, submit financial documents for your I-20 request:

- Financial Guarantee form
- Recent bank statement or scholarship letter, showing no less than the estimated expenses on the Financial Guarantee form
