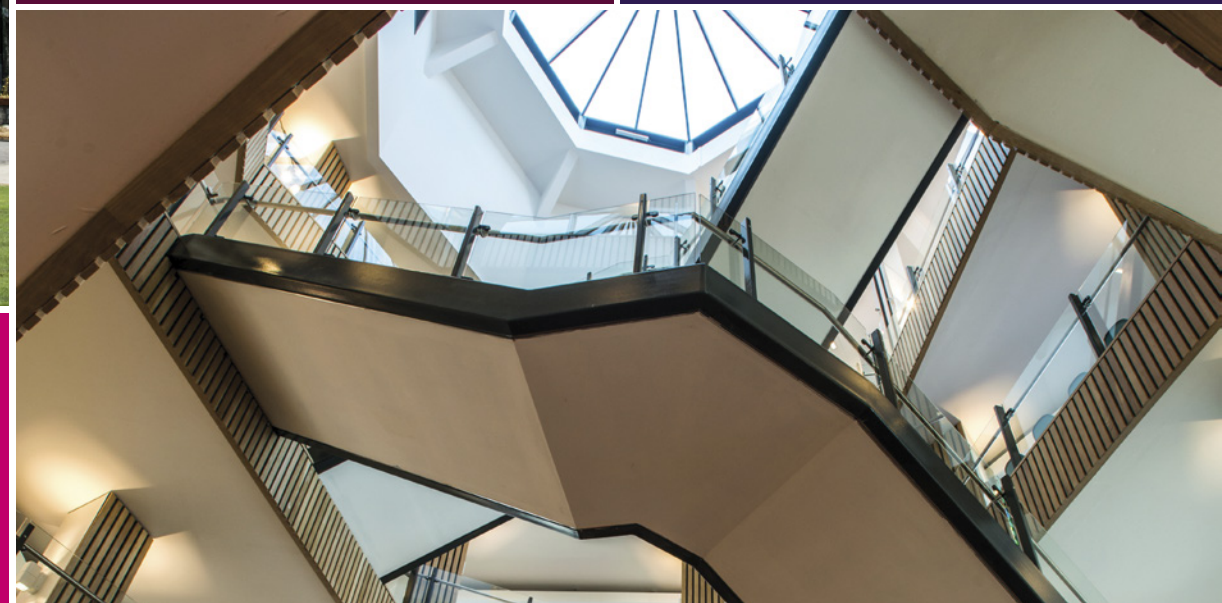
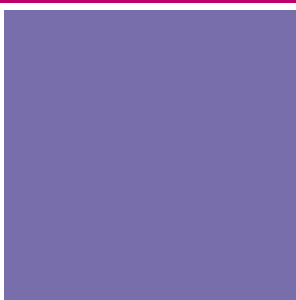

THE INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE ON THE LANSDOWNE CAMPUS

Lansdowne Campus

Situated close to Bournemouth town centre, Lansdowne Campus is where most of BU's accommodation is based, alongside the Executive Business Centre and brand new Health Sciences building. It's a short walk from the beach and many shops, restaurants and bars.

Talbot Campus

Talbot is the University's larger campus and is home to most of BU's excellent facilities. Here, you can find the Student Centre and SportBU, as well as the Faith and Reflection multi-faith chaplaincy centre, which hosts regular 'Global Café' social events for international students.

Culture and shopping

You can see artworks and artefacts at the Russell-Cotes Art Gallery and Museum, browse independent shops and high street stores, or watch your favourite bands play at the Bournemouth International Centre. One thing's for sure – you won't be bored!

Beautiful nature

Bournemouth has lovely parks, like the Alum Chine Tropical Gardens, and Hengistbury Head nature reserve. Alternatively, take a trip out of town to visit the famous Stonehenge or the historic city of Bath, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Watersports like surfing, paddleboarding and swimming are all popular pastimes. If you'd rather stay out of the water, you can stroll along the promenade or enjoy some freshly caught seafood, like local Dorset oysters.

International influence

DEGREE PREPARATION

If you want to study for a degree at Bournemouth University, you can gain entry by taking a pathway course at Bournemouth University International College. Based in the heart of the town, the international college will help you prepare and qualify for entry to a degree.

Take a pathway course

As an international student, you might need or benefit from a pathway course before your university degree. A pathway course is often necessary because of differences between the education system in your home country and that of the UK. It can also help you improve your academic and language qualifications to the level needed to start your degree.

The college is based on the Lansdowne Campus, and you'll have access to many of the university's facilities while on your course. 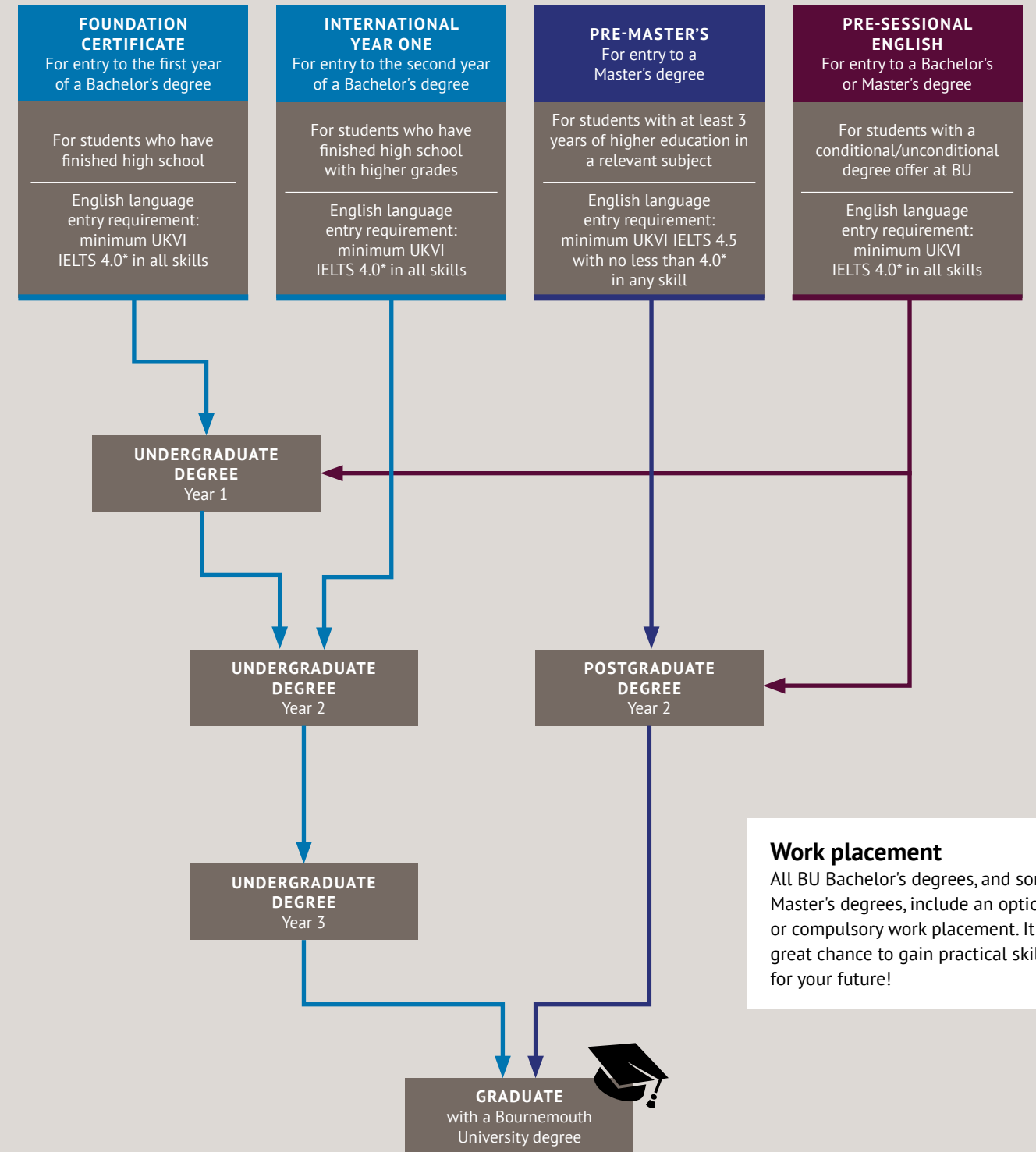

In some cases, you may be able to customise what you study by selecting modules or choosing project topics that match your interests.

Your arrival in the UK

You can also take advantage of Pathways Preview, which gives you early access to educational resources. If you're under 18 years old, Kaplan can help organise a comprehensive guardianship service from a recognised and established guardianship company.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applying with Kaplan is simple. Simply choose a course and degree, and then follow the steps below.

1. Submit your application form

We'll guide you through the entire application process, including what documents you'll need to send with or after your application. Just get in touch, or apply online: kaplanpathways.com/bournemouth-apply

2. Receive an offer letter

Once your complete application has been reviewed, you'll receive either an unconditional or conditional offer, or we can explore other options with you. We'll send a decision within one working day.

3. Accept your offer

You'll do this by paying your deposit to study and admin fee, or sending your financial guarantee. You can also now book your accommodation using the accommodation portal, so you'll have a safe place to live during your studies.

4. Obtain your student visa

To study a pathway course in the UK, you'll typically need to obtain a student visa. We'll advise you on this important process, and we'll provide the supporting documents you'll need for your visa application.

5. Book your flight and begin your studies

The most important step: arrive in the UK and begin your life-changing adventure as an international student!
