Why study a pathway course with internship?

The best way to boost your CV is with real, practical experience. During your internship, you'll gain technical skills in your field of interest, as well as the opportunity to develop your English in a business context. Plus, you can do this all before you progress to your university degree.

A pathway course with internship covers all the same material as our other degree preparation courses. The only difference is that when you've completed the academic part of the course, you'll move onto a one-term, integrated internship. The internships are arranged by Virtual Internships, a top European EdTech company.

You'll complete the placement fully remotely, so you can be flexible with the location of your placement — in fact, there are more than 3,500 host companies across 70 countries worldwide! There are also 18 different career fields available, meaning you'll be matched to an opportunity that suits you and your career goals.

Working in the UK after graduation

Your international journey doesn't have to end after you graduate. With the UK government's Graduate visa, you can stay in the country to work for up to two years after finishing your studies.

It doesn't matter whether you studied an undergraduate or a postgraduate degree, all you need is a current Student visa to be eligible to apply.
