

Office for Students registration: Student visa privileges by UK college

Our registration with the Office for Students (OfS) means many students who were granted a Student visa on or after 24 November 2020¹ now have access to certain privileges, such as being allowed to undertake paid or unpaid work during their pathway course, and to submit an alternative proof of English language to a UKVI-approved Secure English Language Test (SELT) as part of their visa application.

Which benefits students may be eligible for varies according to their college and course type, including whether or not a course is classified by UKVI as a degree-level programme.
