- recent bank statement or scholarship letter showing no less than the minimum funds required

- minimum 500-word personal statement
- ☐ 2 reference letters from professors/instructors or employers
- CV/résumé (optional for undergraduates, mandatory for graduates)
- ☐ GMAT or GRE score (if required, graduate students only)
