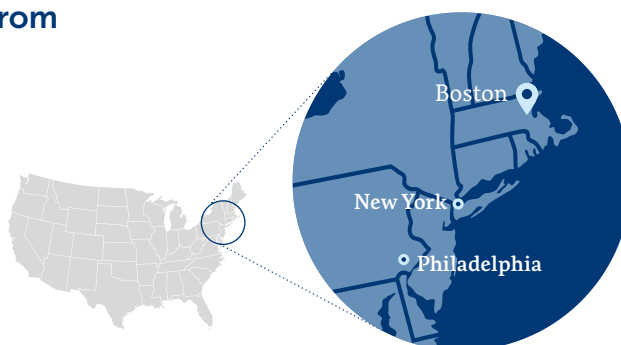

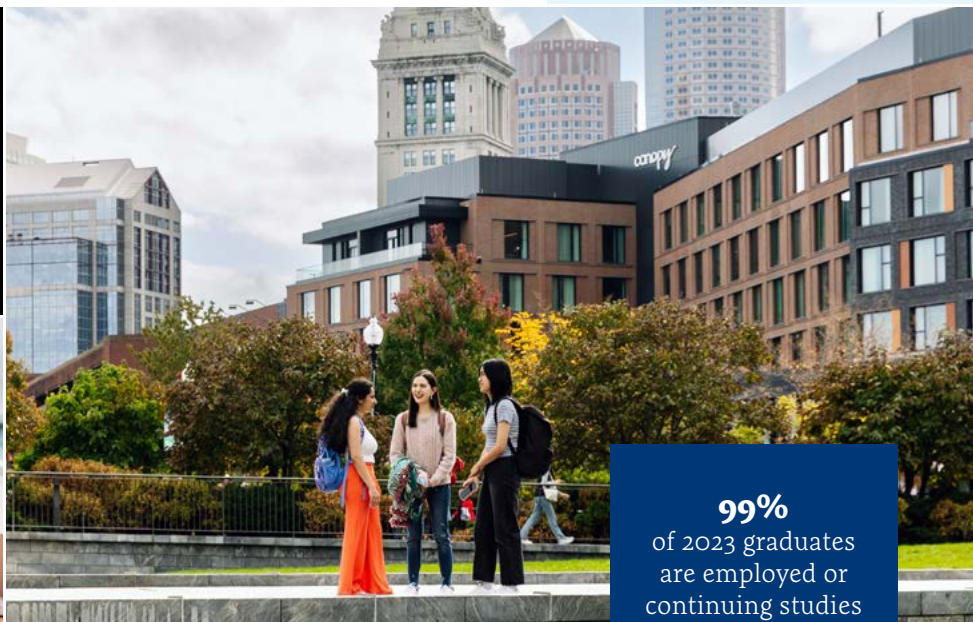

Application checklist

Go to: kaplanpathways.com/apply-simmons and submit the following documents:

- ☐ Application form completed and signed
- ☐ Copy of passport
- ☐ Official transcripts for the last 3 years of education (with official English translations, if needed)
- ☐ English Test — PDF of official score report
- ☐ 1 letter of recommendation — from a teacher or high school counselor
- ☐ Written personal statement (word count 250–650)
- ☐ Scholarship application video — describe your interest in women's leadership by recording a short video (maximum 3 minutes); writing an essay; or attending a 15-minute online interview.

After admission submit financial documents for your I-20 request:

- ☐ International Student Supplement Form (ISSF)
- ☐ Copy of scholarship award letter from Simmons.
- ☐ Recent bank statement or bank letter, showing no less than the estimated expenses on the ISSF form
