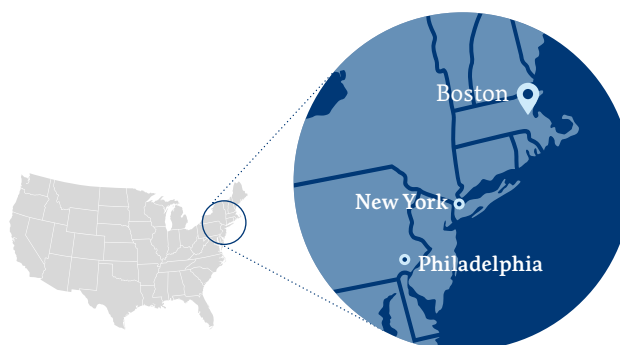

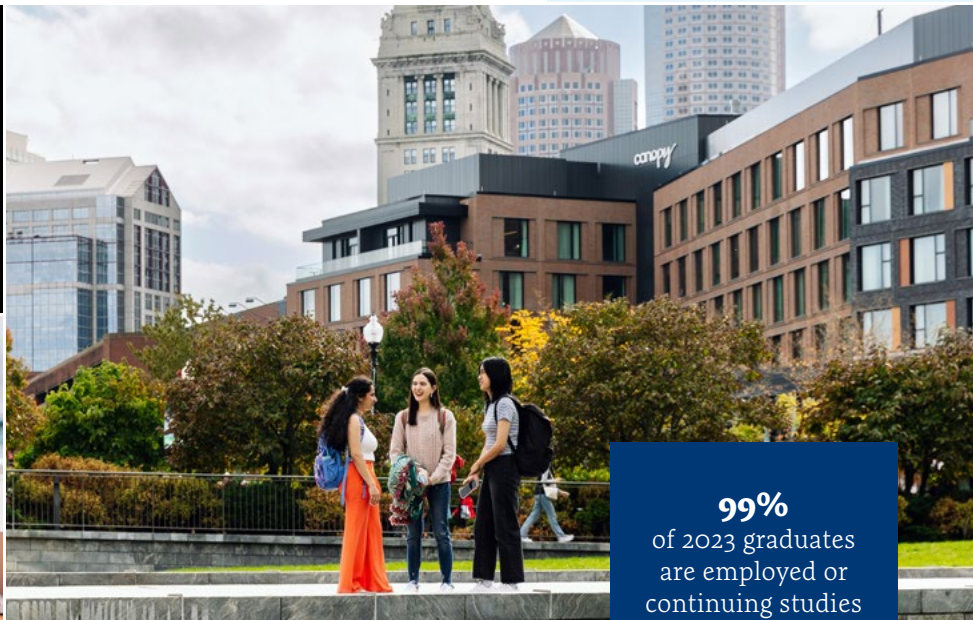

## Scholarships

All undergraduate students are eligible for a renewable merit scholarship — no separate application required! Tuition scholarships are automatically awarded to graduate student.

- Undergraduate students: \$22,000–33,000 (up to \$128,000 over four years)
- Graduate students: up to \$20,000

## Application checklist

- ☐ Application form completed and signed
- ☐ Copy of passport
- ☐ Official transcripts for the last 3 years of education (with official English translations, if needed)
- ☐ NACES evaluation — for Graduate and Transfer students who have completed credits at an international school
- ☐ English Test — PDF of official score report
- ☐ 1 letter of recommendation — from a teacher or high school counselor
- ☐ Written personal statement (word count 250–650)

**After admission submit financial documents for your I-20 request:**

- ☐ International Student Supplement Form (ISSF)
- ☐ Copy of scholarship award letter from Simmons.
- ☐ Recent bank statement or bank letter, showing no less than the estimated expenses on the ISSF form
