

Combined Degree Program 4+4 Pathway



SIMMONS UNIVERSITY

Simmons University, the only women's centered University in Boston, Massachusetts, has joined with St. George's University to offer students an opportunity to obtain a unique Bachelor of Science/Doctor of Medicine degree. Enrolled students spend the first four years of their studies as part of Simmons University's premedical program. Qualified students then proceed to Grenada to enter SGU's four-year Doctor of Medicine program.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Applications are reviewed holistically by the teams at Simmons University and St. George's University. However, some general guidelines include:

Simmons

- o Strong high school grades in the sciences and math
- O Upon conclusion of the undergraduate program, students must maintain a GPA of 3.4 or above
- o Must meet all admissions criteria of SGU School of Medicine
- Students should apply to the joint program when applying for admission at Simmons University

ADVANTAGES

- Students enter St. George's University's medical program directly, without competing for a slot
- SGU students can complete their clinical training and residency requirements at an extensive network of hospitals both in the US and internationally
