For students applying to start in Fall 2025

Important dates (all programs, campuses, admission types)

| August 1, 2024 | Fall 2025 applications open |
| March 1, 2025 | Admission decision notification begins. Transfer and regional campus applications submitted after this date – you will be notified of their admission decision approximately 4 to 6 weeks after your application is complete |
| June 1, 2025 | Deposit deadline – once admitted, you must pay your enrollment deposit to secure your place at UConn. Students with offers issued close to or after this date have 2 weeks to pay their deposit |
| August 1, 2025 | I-20 request deadline — but we recommend you request your I-20 as soon as you've paid your deposit, to allow time to book your visa appointment |
| August 15, 2025* | International student move-in day |
| August 19, 2025* | Orientation — this is also the latest you can arrive on campus to enroll for the Fall 2024 semester |
| August 26, 2025 | Fall classes start |

| December 1 | All campuses | Priority application deadline for scholarship consideration |
| December 15 | Storrs | Advised earlier deadline for applying via Kaplan to Acting, Design and Technical Theatre, Music, Puppet Arts or Theatre Studies majors. These programs require scheduling an audition or interview by January or have an earlier deadline. Therefore your UConn general admission application must be fully submitted (i.e. application status must be "complete" in the UConn portal) in advance. |
| 2025 | | |
| January 1 | Storrs | Advised earlier deadline for applying via Kaplan to Art, Art History, or Digital Media and Design majors. These programs require additional materials submitted via Slideroom, with a deadline of January 15. Therefore your UConn general admission application must be fully submitted (i.e. application status must be "complete" in the UConn portal) in advance |
| January 15 | Storrs | Official application deadline for most majors |
| March 15 | UConn Stamford | If university housing is required |
| May 1 | Regional campuses | UConn Stamford – if university housing is not required; UConn Avery Point, UConn Hartford, UConn Waterbury |

| March 15 | Storrs | Advised earlier deadline for applying via Kaplan to Art History or Theatre Studies majors. These programs require additional materials submitted via Slideroom, with a deadline of April 1. Therefore your UConn general admission application must be fully submitted (i.e. application status must be "complete" in the UConn portal) in advance. |
| April 1 | Storrs | Most majors: Allied Health Sciences, Agriculture & Natural Resources, Animal Science, Applied Resource Economics, Environmental Sciences, Environmental Studies, Landscape Architecture, Natural Resources, Nutritional Sciences, Pathobiology, Sustainable Plant & Soil Systems, School of Business, School of Engineering, College of Liberal Arts & Sciences, Pharmacy Studies |
| May 1 | Regional campuses | UConn Stamford – if university housing is not required; UConn Avery Point, UConn Hartford, UConn Waterbury |

Housing application deadlines

|---------|----------------|--------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| May 1 | Storrs | Priority consideration for a place in one of UConn's 34 Learning Communities. |
| May 24* | UConn Stamford | Priority on-campus housing application deadline — early completion is recommended as space is limited. Students admitted after April 1 who are interested in university housing will be considered on a space-available basis. |
| June 14 | Storrs | General on-campus housing application*** — housing assignments will be confirmed in early August. |

** Some programs require supplemental application materials to be submitted directly to the program — these might have different deadlines from what is listed above.
