



# Start your success story at the Birmingham International Academy (BIA)

At the BIA you can take a degree preparation course on campus to prepare for, and gain entry to, a Birmingham degree.





#### **Foundation pathways**

Course length: 8–12 months Minimum English language level: UKVI IELTS 5.5 to 6.0 or accepted equivalent Intakes: September, November and January, leading to degree entry in September each year 2025-26 tuition fees: from £23,660 Scholarships: Partial tuition scholarships offered for both pathway courses and degrees Degree options: 170+ undergraduate degrees of typically 3-5 years in a wide range of subjects

# **Pre-Sessional English**

Course length: between 4 and 31 weeks Minimum English language level: UKVI IELTS 4.0 or accepted equivalent Intakes: Multiple entry points, leading to degree entry in September each year 2024-25 tuition fees: from £2,200 Scholarships: Partial tuition scholarships offered for both pathway courses and degrees
