

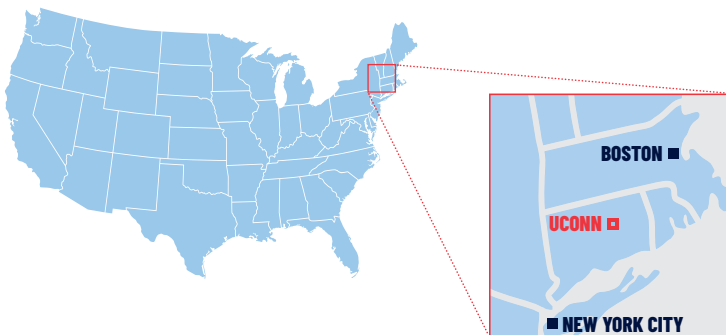

APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

- application form completed and signed:
kaplanpathways.com/apply-uconn
- proof of English proficiency
- official transcripts for all high school and post-high school institutions attended
- personal statement (250–650 words)
- 2 letters of recommendation (optional but encouraged)
- SAT/ACT score (optional)
- applicants to some fine arts degrees must submit a portfolio, audition or interview
- résumé or list of extracurricular activities (highly encouraged)
- copy of passport (and previous I-20 if you have one)

AFTER ADMISSION:

Submit the following financial documents for I-20 request:

- International Student Financial Declaration Form
- recent bank statement or scholarship letter, showing no less than the estimated expenses on the Financial Declaration Form.

APPLICATION DEADLINES FOR FALL START:

- December 1:** priority deadline for scholarship consideration
- January 31:** general deadline for Kaplan applicants to the Storrs main campus
- April 1:** deadline for most transfer applications (some programs have earlier dates)
- May 1:** deadline for UConn regional campuses
