SCHOLARSHIPS

UConn considers first-year undergraduate applicants for renewable merit scholarships worth up to \$60,000 over 4 years[†] and graduate applicants for awards up to \$9,000. No separate application is required, but early applicants have a higher chance of getting an award. First-year undergraduates with exceptional accomplishments may also apply for the Stamps Scholarship, which, if awarded, covers the full cost of attendance.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

- application form completed and signed: kaplanpathways.com/apply-uconn
- proof of English proficiency
- official academic transcripts
- personal statement (250–650 words undergraduate applicants)
- 2 letters of recommendation (optional but encouraged for undergraduate applicants)
- GRE/GMAT optional for master's applicants
- undergraduate applicants to some fine arts degrees must submit a portfolio, audition or interview
- résumé or list of extracurricular activities (highly encouraged for undergraduate applicants)
- copy of passport (and previous I-20 if you have one)
- **FERM** applicants are required to submit an additional essay

FOR I-20 REQUEST:

- International Student Financial Declaration Form
- recent bank statement or scholarship letter, showing no less than the estimated expenses on the Financial Declaration Form

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Undergraduate programs (Fall start only)

December 1: priority deadline for scholarship consideration **February 1:** Kaplan deadline for March 1 admission notification (most Storrs programs)

After February 1: Kaplan applications continue to be accepted for Storrs

April 1: deadline for most transfer applications

May 1: deadline for other UConn campuses

Graduate programs

July 23: Fall start deadline

December 18: Spring start deadline
