Next steps for UO admitted students

1. As soon as you're admitted, **register for on-campus housing**. You will be sent an email invite to UO's on-campus housing portal. First-year students are guaranteed housing, however, to get your preferred choice, it's important to register your interest and preference early.

2. You'll receive a link to the International **Intent to Register** form via email. The online form reserves your place at UO. The deadline of May 1 has been extended for Kaplan applicants but complete this as soon as possible. You must also pay a \$200 tuition deposit that goes toward your first term.

3. Send your **final credentials or transcripts** from your high school studies to UO. School Counsellors can email your final transcripts, or you can submit the official exam scores.

4. Submit your financial documents and **request your I-20** to start the student visa application process. This could be scholarship letters, bank statements, or certificates of deposit, for example. Do this through the Application Status Portal.

5. Set up your student accounts: a) **claim your Duck ID**, b) access Duck Web, c) set up your Personal Access Code (PAC). Your Duck ID is your UO login to access all student platforms.

6. Register for IntroDUCKtion – UO's **new student orientation** program. This happens one week before classes start. Orientation includes academic advising, course registration, meeting other new international students, and getting ready for your first day of class.

Summary of UO student portals

Portal	System	Timeline	Notes
Application Status Portal	Slate	Sent to student within 3-5 business days of application submission	Students are able to update and self-serve if they forget their login/password.
Scholarship Dashboard	Financial Aid	Information on login is sent after student submits application	New system for Winter 2025 onward. Login is likely to use 95# (UOID) but will have a different password than other systems which use the same login.
Housing Application	StarRez	Typically opens in December each year; students must be admitted to login	Students use their 95# (UOID#) to login to the system, until they claim their DuckID. Once they have claimed their DuckID, they need to use that going forward.
DuckWeb	Banner Self-Service	Notification of login is sent to fall-start students in March if they have viewed their admission decision, or rolling from that point forward	System for accepting financial aid, registering, and checking transferable credit.
DuckID	Email System	Sent to students based on entry term: Summer/Fall – Early April Winter – Late September Spring – Mid January	Becomes student's email address as well as login for most systems on campus. Required prior to attending IntroDucktion (orientation). Students can claim 3–5 business days after they have accepted their admission, and it is after the DuckID claim dates.
ISSS (iConnect)	Canvas	Future international students can log in with their University ID number, limited access PIN, and date of birth before they get their DuckID.	Online services for international students, including registration for international student orientation. Full access to services requires a UO Duck ID and password.
myUOHealth	Medicat	Allow 24 hours after claiming your Duck ID before logging into the portal	Students should use this portal to manage immunization records and register their health insurance.



- **Purpose:** Allows students to check the status of their application, view their decision letters, upload documents, complete the intent to register, register for orientation, and request I-20 forms.
- **Account setup:** Once a student's application is submitted to UO, they receive an email with a PIN code to create their account. This email is sent to the email address provided in the application and is typically delivered within 3-5 business days.



They will then see a link “Status Update” on the portal. If they click this link, they will be able to view their decision and a soft copy of their message:


Register for orientation

Registration for in-person IntroDUCKtion sessions will open on May 19, 2025, at 10:00 am PDT for all new students who have submitted their Intent to Register and their Advance Tuition Deposit. Students should register themselves and can also register guests in their [application status portal](#). They should choose the session that is best for them,

and that they can attend from start to finish.


- **Purpose:** Allows students to access information related to scholarships after submitting their application.
- **Account setup:** For login, students should use their 95# (UID), but the password will be different from the one used for other systems. They can access the scholarship dashboard after their application is submitted by Kaplan.

More information

Within a few days of submitting their application to UO, students can find their nine-digit UO Student ID number (this number starts with a 95) in their Status Portal. They need to enter this number at <https://uoregon.scholarships.ngwebsolutions.com/Account/RequestAccount> to create an account. This action will send the student a message to the email address they used to apply to the University of Oregon.

Housing Application (StarRez)



- **Purpose:** admitted students will receive an email inviting them to log in and register for housing. Students must be admitted before they can log in to StarRez. Once logged in, they can apply for housing and manage their housing status. Students can also request housing exemptions through this portal.
- **Account setup:** opens in December for admitted students. Students should use their 95# (UOID#) to log in to the system until they claim their DuckID. After claiming their DuckID, they should use it for all future access.

New students will use the UO ID login option and then register (create an account) in the My Housing portal using the 95# in the email they are sent. Click the “Register Today” button to get started!

DuckWeb (Banner self-service)

- **Purpose:** allows current students to view and update personal data, register for classes, check transferable credits, and accept financial aid awards. Notifications are term-dependent, and students are notified based on term of entry. Students can use this portal to update their personal data.
- **Account setup:** sent to students depending on term admitted. For Fall term: students are notified in March if they are admitted and have viewed their decision. Notifications continue rolling from that point forward. For “off-terms” (Winter, Spring, Summer): students are notified after viewing their application decision.



How to log in

To log in, students should enter their UO ID number (beginning with 95, without dashes) and their Personal Access Code (PAC), then click on the Login button.

First-time Users: Use the UO ID and initial PAC provided by the University of Oregon. After logging in, DuckWeb will notify you that your PAC has expired. You will be prompted to set a new PAC and activate a security question.

DuckID Account Management (email and network access)

- **Purpose:** Serves as a student’s email address as well as primary network login for most systems on campus. Required prior to attending IntroDucktion (orientation).
- **Account setup:** DuckID claiming is scheduled based on a student’s entry term: see below. Once claiming begins, students must wait 3–5 business days after they have accepted their offer of admission before they can claim their DuckID.

Term of entry	DuckID account claiming begins
Winter term	Late September
Spring term	Middle of January
Summer or fall term	Early April

(Guidance on How to Claim Your Duck ID Account from the [UO Service Portal](#)):

When students can claim their Duck ID

Students must accept their admission before they can claim their Duck ID. They should wait 2 business days after accepting their admission before attempting to claim it.

How students can claim their Duck ID

To claim your Duck ID, you will need your UO ID number (starts with 95) and access to the email you used to apply.

1. Go to [Duck ID Account Management](#)
2. Click Claim Your Duck ID
3. Enter your 95#
4. Go to the email address indicated to retrieve your PIN
5. Enter PIN
6. Click banner: Please review the university policy for acceptable use of computing systems
7. Read and accept the Terms of Service

8. Click banner: Please enroll security questions
9. Complete four standard and two user defined questions.
 - Answers are not case-sensitive
10. Click Update
11. PLEASE WAIT A MOMENT
12. You will see a pop-up window: Claim a Duck ID account
13. Select a Duck ID from the drop down options
 - The selected Duck ID will also be your email address
14. Click Next
15. Enter a password and confirm.
 - Requirements will turn green as they are met
16. Click Submit
17. You will see the message Your request was successfully submitted, then this enrollment task is complete
18. You are done and can logout

How students can set up UO mail:

Once the student claims their DuckID, they need to set up the UOmail app on their phone or laptop. Their UO email address will be their "duckid@uoregon.edu". Students must regularly check their inboxes by going to UOMail at <http://uomail.uoregon.edu> and logging in with their full @uoregon.edu address and DuckID password.

When can students start using their DuckID

After a student claims their DuckID, they may have to wait up to one week before they can apply for on-campus housing or access other online portals. Students cannot use their DuckID right away to access online portals.

- **Purpose:** provides a variety of online services for University of Oregon international students. New students can register for international student orientation and request SEVIS transfer-in. Current students use it to submit requests for travel signatures, authorization of reduced course loads, and to access alerts and notes for maintaining legal student status.
- **Account setup:** Incoming and future international students can log in for limited services with their University ID number, limited access PIN, and date of birth. Full access to iConnect Services requires a UO Duck ID and password.
