Merit scholarships for international students

International students are automatically considered for renewable merit scholarships of up to \$20,000 per year. These awards are available to admitted first-year students enrolling in the fall term (September start) who have not attended another college after high school graduation. Merit scholarships from UO can be combined with need-based awards.

UO Excellence	\$20,000, renewable each year*	Apply for admission by January 15 . Submit all required documents by February 15 . No separate scholarship application required.	Limited number awarded to students with exceptional academic records plus strong applications, including extra-curricular activities, awards, and the optional second essay
Summit	\$12,500, renewable each year*	Apply for admission by January 15 . Submit all required documents by February 15 . No separate scholarship application required.	Minimum 3.90 high school GPA on a 4.00 scale
Арех	\$10,000, renewable each year*	Apply for admission by January 15 . Submit all required documents by February 15 . No separate scholarship application required.	Minimum 3.70 high school GPA on a 4.00 scale
International Baccalaureate (IB)	\$2,000–\$6,000, renewable each year*	Follow deadlines above, then submit a copy of your IB Diploma by September 1.	 Minimum 3.40 high school GPA on a 4.00 scale IB diploma with an IB test score of 24 or higher

* Awards renew for up to four or five years (depending on degree program length) provided you maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and enroll full-time (12 credits per term).

Scholarships for international students with financial need

After applying to the University of Oregon, eligible students can submit a separate application for a variety of need-based awards.

Scholarship	Amount	Application deadline	Eligibility
International Cultural Service Program (ICSP)	Up to \$25,000, renewable each year	February 14 for scholarship application	Awarded based on financial need, academic merit, and the ability to make presentations to diverse groups of people
Division of Global Engagement Endowed Scholarships	\$1,000-\$12,000	February 14 for scholarship application	Scholarships have varying eligibility criteria but all require: • demonstration of financial need • minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA

On-campus work opportunities

Work-study awards are given to eligible international students each year by UO. This award provides a monthly paycheck for on-campus work (up to 20 hours per week). The award does not guarantee a job, but opportunities for on-campus employment are greatly increased. However, international students can also apply for paid work on campus without a work-study award.

Scholarship	Amount	Application deadline	Eligibility
International Student Work-Study	\$1,000-\$4,500	Apply for admission by January 15 , then apply for the work-study award by April 15 .	Awarded based on financial need. Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA and satisfactory academic progress towards degree completion
