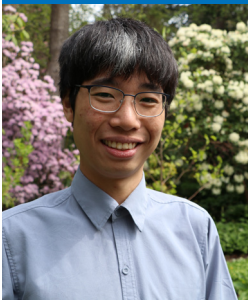

Turn lessons into experience during your studies at UVic:

- **Off-campus job:** up to 24 hours per week.
- **Post-Graduation Work Permit:** stay and work in Canada after graduation for up to three years, even if you've completed a shorter one-year Master's program.
